POLK STATE GATEWAY TO COLLEGE CHARTER HIGH SCHOOL

SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY 2021

An external evaluator from Smart Teams created this report, summarizing the responses of Polk State Gateway to College Charter High School's stakeholders on the school's 2021 climate survey. The report provides an overall summary of survey results as well as an examination of responses by survey item and category.

The report is divided into three parts:

Part 1: Overall Survey Results

The Polk State Gateway to College Charter High School Climate Survey was administered to parents, students, and staff members in the spring 2021. The number of participants in each category included:

- 94 parents
- 55 seniors
- 58 juniors
- 11 staff members

These numbers represent approximately 36% of the school's parents, 43% of students, and 85% of staff.

Survey items are organized around seven categories or correlates associated with characteristics that are evident in highly effective schools. Categories include:

- Correlate 1/Safe and Orderly Environment
- Correlate 2/High Expectations
- Correlate 3/Instructional Leadership

- Correlate 4/Clear School Mission
- Correlate 5/Opportunity to Learn
- Correlate 6/Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- Correlate 7/Home-School Community Relationship

The survey template lists 24 statements about the school. For each survey item, the respondent is asked to indicate whether he or she strongly disagrees (1), disagrees (2), agrees (3), or strongly agrees (4).

Part 2 (page 4) of this report, provides a summary of responses by correlate for each stakeholder group. Selected overall observations for all respondents are as listed below:

- A total of 218 stakeholder representatives participated in the survey process.
- The overall responses by group are:
 - Students 3.49 (juniors 3.28 and seniors 3.71)
 - o Parents 3.31
 - Staff 3.41
- The highest ratings awarded by each stakeholder group were as listed below:
 - Staff (3.67)—Clear School Mission
 - Seniors (3.81)—Instructional Leadership
 - Juniors (3.34)—High Expectations
 - o All students (3.56)—Instructional Leadership/Opportunity to Learn
 - o Parents (3.40)—Clear School Mission
- Lowest ratings of each group included:
 - Staff (3.21)—Safe and Orderly
 - o Seniors (3.63)—Safe and Orderly/Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress

- Juniors (3.14)—Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- All students (3.38)— Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- Parents (3.25)— Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- The mean or average scores for parents, students, and staff are 3 or higher for all seven survey categories or correlates. The school thus meets the requirements of one of its charter goals, which states, "The average responses of students, parents, and staff equals 3.0 or higher on at least 6 of 7 correlates on the annual climate survey (scale of 1.0 to 4.0)"

Part 2: Average Responses by Correlate

The columns in **Table 1** list the seven survey correlates and the overall average by subgroup and year. The rows list mean responses of stakeholder groups on the items included in each correlate. The final column to the right lists the average or mean score for the stakeholder group. The bold mean score in each row is the highest reported for the group.


Additionally, the bottom rows (*Overall*) of the table list the average or mean rating given by parents, all students, and staff by year for each correlate.

Part 3: Individual Survey Item Responses

In addition to reporting the average scores by correlate, survey results were analyzed to determine the average response by survey item and the percent of respondents indicating they *strongly agree*, *agree*, *disagree*, and *strongly disagree* with each survey statement.

Tables 3, 5, 7, and 9 list individual survey statements, the number of participants who chose each response for a statement, and the statement's average score (Table 3 juniors, Table 5 seniors, Table 7 parents, and Table 9 staff).

Tables 4, 6, 8 and 10 list individual survey items and the percent of respondents indicating that they *strongly agree*, *agree*, *disagree*, and *strongly disagree* with each statement (Table 4 juniors, Table 6 seniors, Table 8 parents and Table 10 staff).
