SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY 2023

Gateway Collegiate High School created this report, summarizing the responses of Polk State Gateway to College Charter High School's (GHS's) stakeholders on the school's 2024 climate survey. The report provides an overall summary of survey results as well as an examination of responses by survey item and category.

The report is divided into three parts:

Part 1: Overall Survey Results

The GHS Climate Survey was administered to parents, students, and staff members in the spring 2023. The number of participants in each category included:

- 61 parents
- 58 seniors
- 91 juniors
- 10 staff members

These numbers show that 25% of the school's parents (61/246), 61% of students (149/246), and 100% of staff (10/10) completed the survey

Additionally, results were analyzed to determine the correlation between the racial/ethnic make-up of the CHS student population and the percent of survey respondents representing each racial/ethnic group. The goal is to solicit surveys with representation proportionate to the make-up of the student population. Actual results for the spring of 2023 are as listed below.

Survey items are organized around seven correlates associated with characteristics that are evident in highly effective schools. Correlates include:

- Correlate 1/Safe and Orderly Environment
- Correlate 2/High Expectations
- Correlate 3/Instructional Leadership
- Correlate 4/Clear School Mission
- Correlate 5/Opportunity to Learn
- Correlate 6/Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- Correlate 7/Home-School Community Relationship

The survey template lists 24 statements about the school. For each survey item, the respondent is asked to indicate whether he or she strongly disagrees (1), disagrees (2), agrees (3), or strongly agrees (4). 2023 survey items are listed in Table 1 below

- 7. Teacher behaviors at the collegiate high school show that they believe that students can achieve on a high level.
- 8. The collegiate high school expects students to be accountable for their learning.

CORRELATE 2: HIGH EXPECTATIONS

- 9. The administration at GHS is visible and involved in student learning.
- 10. The principal at the collegiate high school provides a good environment for learning.
- 11. The principal at the collegiate high school makes quality decisions to influence student learning.

CORRELATE 3: INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERSHIP

- 12. I believe the main focus of the collegiate high school is to help its students succeed.
- 13. The collegiate high school's goals and purpose are clear.
- 14. The collegiate high school is preparing students for college and future challenges.

CORRELATE 4: CLEAR MISSION

- 15. The collegiate high school provides a variety of programs and subjects.
- 16. The focus for students at the collegiate high school is academic studies.
- 17. The instructors at the collegiate high school help students with their studies.

CORRELATE 5: OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN

- 18. Students receive frequent updates on their progress in high school courses at GHS.
- 19. The instructors are quick to help and assist when students struggle with coursework at the collegiate high school.
- 20. Students are aware of their progress at the collegiate high school.

CORRELATE 6: FREQUENT MONITORING OF STUDENT PROGRESS

- 21. Parents are encouraged to provide input and information to improve the collegiate high school.
- 22. Parents are welcome to visit the collegiate high school.
- 23. Staff, parents and students are informed of meetings and activities at GHS.
- 24. I am satisfied with the education that students receive from the collegiate high school.

CORRELATE 7: HOME SCHOOL COMMUNITY CONNECTION

Part 2 (page 5) of this report, provides a summary of responses by correlate for each stakeholder group. Selected overall observations for all respondents are as listed below:

- A total of 220 stakeholder representatives participated in the survey process.
- The overall responses by group are:
 - Students 3.30 (juniors 3.30 and seniors 3.30)
 - Parents 3.42
 - Staff 3.71
- Stakeholder groups gave their highest correlate ratings to:
 - Clear School Mission—Seniors (3.37) and parents (3.51)
 - High Expectations—Juniors(3.42)
 - Instructional Leadership—Staff (3.87)
- Lowest ratings of each group include:
 - Staff (3.41) and parents (3.31) —Safe and Orderly Environment
 Seniors (3.24)—Home-School Community Relationship

 - Juniors (3.15)—Frequent Monitoring of Student Progress
- The mean or average scores for parents, students, and staff are 3 or higher for all seven survey correlates. The school thus meets the requirements of one of its charter goals, which states, "The average responses of students, parents, and staff equals 3.0 or higher on at least 6 of 7 correlates on the annual climate survey (scale of 1.0 to 4.0)"

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Part 2: Average Responses by Correlate

The columns in Table 2 list the seven survey correlates and the overall average by subgroup and year. The rows list mean responses of stakeholder groups on the items included in each correlate. The final column to the right lists the average or mean score for the stakeholder group. The bold mean score in each row is the highest reported for the group.


Additionally, the bottom rows (Overall) of the table list the average or mean rating given by parents, all students, and staff by year for each correlate.

Three survey items, included in the scores listed in Figure 1, are tied to two issues deemed to be significant enough in importance to also be reported independently:

- Bullying
- Overall satisfaction with the school
