- a. Student Activities & Leadership Office (SALO)
 - President Garcia Falconetti introduced Ms. Aaliyah Jones, President, Lakeland Student Government Association (SGA), and Mr. Jamior Flis, Student Engagement Specialist, Lakeland SGA to provide an update on SGA goals and accomplishments for this year. Ms. Jones shared that unity has been the central theme for all endeavors.
 - The students presented an SGA jacket to Chair Martinez and provided a small token of appreciation to the rest of the Board members.

b. Beth Luckett, Dean, Health Sciences

- President Garcia Falconetti introduced Dean Luckett, who shared several highlights across the eight Health Sciences programs.
 - Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) first returning cohort to start May 2024 with 37 applications and 23 qualified to fill 24 seats.
 - Cardiovascular Technology (CVT) investigating the addition of an electrophysiology (EP) component to curriculum to increase job opportunities and credentialing.
 - Diagnostic Medical Sonography (DMS) December 2023 graduates had 100% board exam pass rate.
 - o Radiography Program (RTE) virtual reality lab now in place at Airside West Center for students to practice working in a simulated X-ray room.
 - Emergency Medical Services (EMR, EMT, Paramedic) working with Lakeland Regional Health ER doctors to finalize a Mass Casualty Incident (MCI) drill at the Polk State Center for Public Safety (CPS).
 - o Across all eight Health Sciences programs, board exam pass rates range from 95% to 100%.
