c. Renovation of Winter Haven Campus Building 4, WFA:

 - An Evaluation Team comprised of 7 administrators, faculty, and staff with expertise in facilities, engineering, instruction, student services, and the arts was selected.
 - The Evaluation Team met today in a public meeting to rank the 6 interested Architect-Engineering firms who submitted applications as a result of a Request for Quotation (RFQ).

- The College's Procurement Services Office will review the rankings presented from this morning's Evaluation Team meeting and the Architect-Engineering firms selected for interviews and oral presentations will be finalized.
- o On January 4, 2022, oral presentations by the selected or shortlisted Architect-Engineering firms will occur.
- The final rankings accompanied by a recommendation will be presented to the Board during its January 24, 2022, DBOT meeting as a request for the College to engage in contract negotiations with the firm that maintains the highest score.

d. Classification and Compensation Study:

- Dr. Falconetti announced that the College will engage in a Classification and Compensation Study with Gallagher.
 - Phase 1 Study Initiation and Information Gathering began in late
 October and will continue through December. This largely consists of the
 review and understanding of current job descriptions, wages, and pay
 structure.
 - <u>Phase 2 Classification and Job Evaluation</u> begins in January and will continue through April. This focuses on analyzing the existing classifications, aligning actual duties to job descriptions, and making recommendations to update classifications and titling conventions.
 - Phase 3 Compensation Study begins in January and will continue through April. This focuses on the labor market for faculty and staff to establish competitive pay tables accounting for district, regional, and state factors.
 - O Phase 4 Project Finalization begins in May and will continue through June. This concludes the project work by incorporating the data and information shared in the earlier phases as well as the input from the constituent groups.
