Polk State College's campuses and centers are to remain open and reserved for purposes that are in accordance with the College's mission.

The administration of Polk State College has the power to bar (or remove from the premises) any person or persons reasonably deemed to create a clear and present danger by advocating or attempting:

- 1. Violent overthrow of the government of the United States, the State of Florida, or any political subdivision thereof.
- 2. Willful destruction or seizure of the College's buildings or other property.
- 3. Disruption or impairment of the College's regularly scheduled classes or other educational functions.
- 4. Criminal activity.
- 5. Physical harm, coercion, intimidation, or other invasion of the lawful rights of the institution's officials, faculty members, or students; or
- 6. Any other campus disorder of a violent or disruptive nature.
