I. Purpose

The purpose of this document is to outline the source and acceptable use of College funding regarding student activities and organizations.

II. Funding Guidelines for Student Activities and Organizations

- Generally, Student Activities and Services Fees (and College funds derived from student activities) are to be expended for the benefit of students currently enrolled at the College. Activities supported by these funds may include, but are not limited to, student clubs and organizations, student media, the Student Government Association (SGA), the Student Activities and Leadership Office (SALO), athletic programs, and student social activities.
- Expenditures from Student Activities and Services Fees are provided according to a budget prepared jointly by Student Government members from the Winter Haven Campus, the Lakeland Campus, and the College's satellite centers, as well as with College staff, and must be approved by the College President.
- The budget is to be based upon an estimate of total funds generated from Student Activities and Services Fees, as well as an estimate of funds carried forward from the prior year.
- 4. All lawful expenditures that benefit the student body in general may be funded from Student Activities and Services Fees if such expenditures are included in the approved budget. Student club and organization advisors are appointed for student activities that are financed by these fees.
