

How to apply to Polk State Chain of Lakes Collegiate High School for the 2021-22 School Year

- 1. It is <u>highly recommended</u> that you attend a recruit/information night on February 9, February 18, or February 23, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. in WST126 on campus at 999 Ave. H. NE, Winter Haven. You must RSVP to Ms. Thigpen at <u>pthigpen@polk.edu</u> to confirm your attendance. At recruit night, you will learn about the acceptance process that takes place after your application is submitted. Masks must be worn on campus.
- 2. Complete an online application to Polk State College at https://www.polk.edu/admission-aid/. Check "Dual Enrollment" (option 4) when asked about your student status.
- 3. Allow 3-5 days to receive your acceptance email from Polk State College.
- 4. Once you receive the acceptance email, visit https://pickatime.com/_ChainofLakes/PERT_Testing_Dates_for_Chain_of_Lakes_Colle giate_High_School_2021-2022_Application_ to make an appointment to take the PERT (Post-Secondary Education Readiness Test). Print your confirmation email and bring it with you to your appointment along with a photo ID.
- 5. Once your PERT is complete, you will need to **obtain a copy of your printed PERT scores**. This must be included with your Chain of Lakes Collegiate application.
- 6. A transcript or student course history is required along with the COL application. If you attend a Polk district school and have access to the Focus Portal, you may obtain a record from the portal or you may obtain this information from your school counselor.
- 7. If you do not attend a Polk district school or do not have access to Focus, you may obtain a transcript or student scholastic record from your school counselor/records office.
- 8. Now you should have your PERT scores and your course record in hand. You are ready to complete the COL application at https://www.polk.edu/chain-of-lakes-collegiate-high-school/. You will be asked to upload your PERT scores and your course record within the application. A clear picture of those documents showing the student's identifying information is acceptable. Be sure to answer every question completely and honestly before you click submit.
- 9. Applications will be accepted from February 1 through March 5, 2021.
